INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing Japan Walk-Caster's Kiyosumi Teien audio tour. Start each track after you reach the corresponding audio point, so listen to track 2 after you reach location 2 on the map.

This park is a typical *kaiyuu* style Daimyo (feudal lord) garden from the Edo period. The park features a pond, artificial hills, and rocks. Part of the park was created by Kinokuniya Bunzaemon, a famous Edo lumber merchant. In 1878, Yataro Iwasaki, founder of the Mitsubishi group, bought the property and built a garden that was used by employees and important business guests. In 1932 the Mitsubishi group donated the garden to the city of Tokyo. It was opened to the public in 1932. The park has designated as a "place of scenic beauty" in Tokyo in 1979.
